		We understand that the student, with the support of parent/guardian, is responsible for the daily care and maintenance of the Chromebook.
		We understand the student must abide by the rules and regulations Acceptable Use Guidelines.
		Failure to abide by this policy may result in disciplinary action and confiscation of Chromebook.
		We understand that the Chromebook should be used <b>ONLY</b> by the student to whom it is issued,
		and that the student is responsible for the Chromebook assigned to them at the start of their year.
		We understand that Chromebooks should be charged using only the provided charging cord.
		Further, we understand we are responsible for the <b>\$25</b> replacement fee that will be assessed for
		lost or damaged chargers.  A <b>Dell</b> charger will be issued when Chromebook is issued, and a <b>Dell</b> charger will be expected at turn
		in. Failure to turn in a Dell charger will also result in a \$25 replacement fee.
		We understand that Chromebooks should remain in the protective case provided by the district at all
		times, and that <b>no stickers</b> should be placed on the case for any reason. Failure to adhere to this
		may result in disciplinary action including loss of Chromebook privileges. We also understand we are
		responsible for the \$25 fee that will be assessed for breakages, stickers placed on cases, as well as
		lost or stolen cases.
		We understand that we must report all Chromebook damages or the theft/loss of the Chromebook to the district technology department as quickly as possible.
		We understand that damage, whether intentional or accidental, to the Chromebook will result in
		financial liability. A <b>\$75</b> deductible will be assessed for the first damage to a Chromebook. Any
		subsequent damages to a Chromebook will be charged either the cost of the repair or full
		replacement fee of <b>\$279</b> (Cost of new Chromebook if deemed unrepairable).
		We understand if the Chromebook is lost or stolen, we will be responsible for the replacement fee of
		<b>\$279.</b> (This will cover the cost of the Chromebook as well as the Google Management License)
		We understand that intentionally modifying any setting or policy on the Chromebook is prohibited and could result in disciplinary action, including loss of Chromebook privileges.
