Randolph Secondary School students will be issued a Google Chromebook for their educational use. With acceptance of the Chromebooks, both the student and their parent/guardian take on certain responsibilities. Acceptance of and adherence to these responsibilities will result in a rich technologically enhanced learning environment for all involved.

RFISD believes with reasonable precautions and care taken with the use of the Chromebook it should not experience physical damage. Each student and their parent/guardian are asked to read this form carefully. The student and parent/guardian should initial next to each statement and sign below.

Use, Proper Care, Precautions, & Personal Responsibilities.

		We understand that the issuance of a Chromebook to each student is not a right but a privilege that can be revoked at any time. The Chromebook and its accessory equipment are the property of Randolph Field ISD.
		We understand that the student, with the support of parent/guardian, is responsible for the daily care and maintenance of the Chromebook.
		We understand the student must abide by the rules and regulations Acceptable Use Guidelines. Failure to abide by this policy may result in disciplinary action and confiscation of Chromebook.
		We understand that the Chromebook should be used ONLY by the student to whom it is issued, and that the student is responsible for the Chromebook assigned to them at the start of their year.
		We understand that Chromebooks should be charged using only the provided charging cord. Further, we understand we are responsible for the \$25 replacement fee that will be assessed for lost or damaged chargers.
		A Dell charger will be issued when Chromebook is issued, and a Dell charger will be expected at turn in. Failure to turn in a Dell charger will also result in a \$25 replacement fee.
		We understand that Chromebooks should remain in the protective case provided by the district at all times, and that no stickers should be placed on the case for any reason. Failure to adhere to this may result in disciplinary action including loss of Chromebook privileges. We also understand we are responsible for the \$25 fee that will be assessed for breakages, stickers placed on cases, as well as lost or stolen cases.
		We understand that we must report all Chromebook damages or the theft/loss of the Chromebook to the district technology department as quickly as possible.
		We understand that damage, whether intentional or accidental, to the Chromebook will result in financial liability. A \$75 deductible will be assessed for the first damage to a Chromebook. Any subsequent damages to a Chromebook will be charged either the cost of the repair or full replacement fee of \$279 (Cost of new Chromebook if deemed unrepairable).
		We understand if the Chromebook is lost or stolen, we will be responsible for the replacement fee of \$279 . (This will cover the cost of the Chromebook as well as the Google Management License)
		We understand that intentionally modifying any setting or policy on the Chromebook is prohibited and could result in disciplinary action, including loss of Chromebook privileges.
		We understand that the Chromebook is a valuable tool in the learning process and all students must have their Chromebooks fully charged and with them EVERY day for EVERY class.
